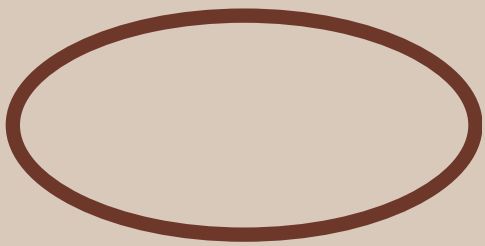

We are going to be busy with paint, crayons, playdough and more during our next unit, “Amazing Art.” Art is a wonderful topic for children to explore and it invites them to share their creativity with others. Your child is going to have plenty of opportunities to explore many different types of art during this unit. Here are a few of the topics we will explore:

- * What is Art?
- * Painting is a Type of Art
- * Mosaics are a Type of Art
- * Almost Anything Can Be an Art Material
- * Drawing is a Type of Art
- * Collage is a Type of Art
- * Sculpture is a Type of Art
- * Mixing Colors

Here are some simple things you can do at home to reinforce our unit, “Amazing Art.”

Bathtime:



Consider purchasing bathtub crayons for your child to explore during bath time. They are a lot of fun!

Mealtime:



Create an “edible mosaic” with cut pieces of cheese and melon. Use square and triangle shapes and arrange on a plate to create a design.

Out & About (Traveling):



Look for art on signs, billboards, buildings and even buses when riding in the car. Art is everywhere!

Bedtime:



When reading books with your child, talk about the art techniques the illustrator used.

Sing the song, “I Can...” with your child and talk about the types of art he/she enjoys.
